



3rd AETOS International Workshop on Research Challenges for Future RPAS/UAS Systems

(May 5, 2015 at the Unmanned Systems 2015 Conference, Atlanta, Georgia)

AETOS is organizing an International Workshop on Research Challenges for Future Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems (RPAS) / Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) for the first time in the US. This workshop is being organized in conjunction with the AUVSI's Conference on Unmanned Systems 2015 and in collaboration with the University of North Texas. It is the third in the series on UAS with applications to real world scenarios.

The conference focuses on UAS, supportive technologies, software environments and the associated key research issues. The aim is to bring together the research community and to provide an opportunity to share experiences and views on current trends and activities in the domain. In addition to regular papers, the workshop highlights student posters and demonstrations that showcase real-world applications of UAS.
